A key component of job searches, the Curriculum Vitae remains a challenge for many people, whether young or more experienced. In one or two pages, the candidate must sell himself or herself favorably yet without arrogance, include all necessary information without overwhelming the reader, and stand out visually without seeking originality for its own sake. Cutting through the subjective, often contradictory advice from the recruiting world, his half-day workshop proposes no-nonsense guidelines toward an effective curriculum vitae in terms of both content and format. It ends with a brief editing exercise, during which participants review the draft curriculum vitae of one another.
