the USA, where he focused his research on auditory synaptic physiology at the Rockefeller University and Stanford University. Back in Europe, he worked at the Universidad Miguel Hernandez in Elche, applying electrophysiological techniques to the study of pancreatic cell physiology and diabetes.

In 2017 he transitioned to science consulting, founding Carreras Cientificas Alternativas, a platform devoted to guide science students and PhDs to find their professional path inside and outside academia. Manolo conducts training seminars and workshops related to professional careers, participates frequently in employability forums and runs a podcast about scientific careers where he interviews researchers who happily made their professional career transition beyond Academia. Manolo currently combines his career guiding activities with recruitment consulting for R&D companies at Talento Cientifico.
